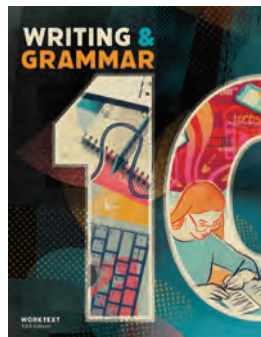

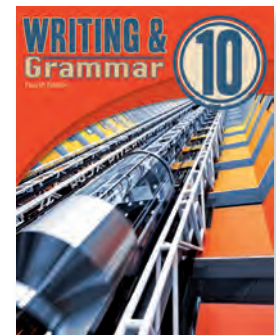
Updates

This edition reflects multiple significant changes from the previous edition. These revisions include multiple textual changes, a newly integrated teaching strategy, and new and removed chapters. Multiple chapters have been added to train student research skills as well as various forms of writing. The page count in the student worktext has increased from 472 to 528. New objectives have been added for non-grammar lessons, and the number of writing assignments and activities has increased.

Because of these changes, this edition is not compatible with its predecessor.

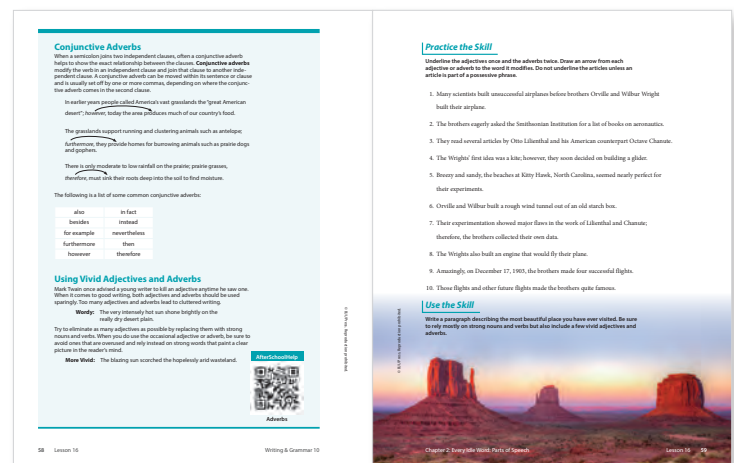
